

## How to Care Bed Linen - Guide



### Washing

- Wash separately from other items to protect the fabric. Remove quickly after the cycle to avoid colour transfer and shake to reduce creases. Ref each product care instructions.
- The care label shows the highest safe temperature, but washing at a lower temperature saves energy.



### Drying

- Whenever possible, line dry sheets in the shade to reduce creasing.
- If using a tumble dryer, choose a low-heat setting. Do not over-dry, as this weakens fibres.
- For best results, remove sheets while slightly damp and iron. If already dry, dampen the fabric before ironing.



### Important Note on Colours and Shrinkage (Reduction)

- Due to the natural fibres used, the colour of the fabric may appear slightly different in person than it does on your screen.
- Please note that with reorders, minor variations in colour may occur between production batches. These subtle differences are a natural part of high-quality fabric production.
- As our products are handcrafted in a sartorial process, sizes may vary slightly compared to industrially produced items.
- We allow extra fabric in the sizes to account for natural shrinkage after washing.
